

University of Detroit Jesuit Homecoming Dance 2021 Updated: 8/30/21

General Information

- The dance will be held outdoors on the backfield at U of D Jesuit High School and Academy on Saturday, September 18, 2021
- Dance begins at 7 PM and doors close at 8:30 PM.
- Dance ends at 10 PM Students may not leave earlier than 9:30 PM.
- Tickets must be purchased in advance; no tickets will be sold at the door.
 - Tickets are \$20/person and will be available for purchase by U of D Jesuit High School students beginning on Wednesday, September 15, 2021 during all lunch periods.
- U of D Jesuit High School students are able to bring one (1) female guest to Homecoming.
 - Students cannot bring a middle school student.
 - Guests cannot be more than two (2) years removed from high school.
- The theme is James Bond

Dress Code

It is the responsibility of U of D Jesuit High School students to communicate these expectations with their date prior to the dance.

- All guests must wear shoes for the duration of the event. The dance is being held outdoors on the football field, therefore, high heels will not be permitted
 - o It is highly recommended that guests wear flats or gym shoes
- Gentlemen:
 - o are not to remove or unbutton their shirts.
 - o are to wear a suit jacket or sports coat and tie while entering the event.
- For our female guests:
 - o the hemline, including slits, must be no shorter than 6" above the knee.
 - o a dress may be backless, as long as they are not cut below the waistline
 - o in general, dresses must not have:
 - midriff-bearing cutouts
 - plunging necklines
 - o If a student is unsure if his date's dress is appropriate, he is encouraged to see Mr. Chandler or Ms. Ong directly.
- T-shirts will be provided during the dance if attire is deemed inappropriate

Covid-19 Protocols

- In order to be admitted to the 2021 Homecoming Dance, all students and guests must either:
 - Show proof of Covid-19 vaccination
 - o Present a negative (-) PCR test for Covid-19, taken within 72 hours of entry
 - Present a positive (+)PCR test for Covid-19, if the student/guest has recovered from COVID-19 in the last 3 months (90 days).
- As mandated by the Wayne County Health Division, masks must be worn indoors. This
 applies to all students, guests, and faculty/staff present, regardless of vaccination status.

All U of D Jesuit students AND their guests must register using the portal linked via the QR code printed on the ticket.

Assessing Vaccination Status

- Students and guests are considered fully vaccinated:
 - 2 weeks after their second dose in a 2-dose series, such as the Pfizer or Moderna vaccines, or
 - o 2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine, such as Johnson & Johnson's Janssen vaccine
- For the Homecoming Dance 2021, the final vaccine dose must have been administered before Saturday, September 4, 2021
- The vaccination status of U of D Jesuit students will be assessed using their vaccination records on file with the school
- Guests can upload a photo of their vaccination card
 - o The name on the vaccination card must match the name of the registered guest
 - The portal to upload these documents can be accessed using the QR code printed on the ticket

PCR Test Information

- A negative (-) PCR Test for Covid-19 can be used to gain admission to the Homecoming Dance. The test must have been taken Wednesday, September 15, 2021 or after.
 - o Rapid or at-home test results will not be accepted.
 - o It is the student/guest's responsibility to have testing done so results are available prior to the Homecoming Dance.
- A positive (+) PCR Test for Covid-19 can also be used if the student/guest has recovered from COVID-19 in the last 3 months (90 days). The positive test must have been taken from Sunday, June 6, 2021 Saturday, September 4, 2021.
- The State of Michigan is providing an <u>online tool</u> to help residents locate testing sites near them throughout the state.
- PCR testing appointments can also be scheduled at various local pharmacies, such as <u>CVS</u> and <u>Walgreens</u>.
- The portal to upload these documents can be accessed using the QR code printed on the ticket
 - o The name on the test result must match the name of the student/registered guest
